

New NHMRC Homeopathy Review

The next 'Australian Report' by the National Health and Medical Research Council (NHMRC) is due for publication late 2021 or early 2022.

This will be considered the most comprehensive and authoritative evaluation of clinical evidence of homeopathy worldwide to date, officially superseding the inaccurate 2015 Australian Report in the scientific literature. Ongoing input to this process since August 2019 from the Homeopathy Research Institute (HRI) has helped to ensure that scientific flaws in the 2015 report will not be repeated. For example, it appears that this review will genuinely assess both efficacy and effectiveness, using an appropriate methodology.

Through active international collaboration with key researchers and other organisations, HRI also responded to NHMRC's Call for Evidence for their new homeopathy review, providing all relevant studies which meets their inclusion criteria, further increasing the chances of a fair, objective and accurate assessment of the evidence.

Australian NHMRC Ombudsman Challenge

In autumn 2020, HRI collaborated with the Australian Homeopathic Association on a new submission to the Ombudsman, criticising the way in which the investigation against NHMRC for their inaccurate Homeopathy Review 2015 has been conducted.

This submission has resulted in the Ombudsman office committing to a full re-evaluation of the case by a new officer in early 2021.

Monthly campaigns

As part of its ongoing work to promote the benefits of homeopathy for a wide range of conditions, 4H continues to provide a monthly focus on conditions and issues. In recent months we have raised mental illness, family health, men's health, and a range of other issues.
